In this class children will get to eat delicious food that they make themselves and -Cooking develops science, math, language, and reading readiness skills:

- Cooking inspires children's curiosity, thinking, and problem solving, offering new opportunities to make predictions and observations
- Basic chemistry as children discover how certain ingredients combine, react, and change as they cook
- Math skills such as counting, measuring, patterning, simple fractions, and one-to-one correspondence
- Discussing what children see, taste, and feel increases their vocabulary
- Reading through a recipe helps children learn how to follow words from left to right, sequencing skills and distinguishing numbers from letters
- Fine-motor skills and eye-hand coordination are enhanced when little fingers tear, stir, and pour
- Children learn about food groups, nutrition, healthy foods and where food comes from
- Children develop teamwork and cooperation as they follow multiple directions with their partner chefs

Children must be 4 by September 30, 2018 to enroll. *This class is not recommended for children with food allergies.
